

POLICY:

OPENING BACKSIDE OF ARAPAHOE PARK May 1st

PURPOSE:

- As an essential business for horse boarding; the backside of Arapahoe Park will be open to horses and licensed personal in order to exercise and train to prepare for opening for racing on June 6th.
- Educate Horseman of the Importance of being actively involved in reducing the spread of COVID-19

PLAN:

- Advise Horsemen that Colorado and Arapahoe County are Hot Spots of Virus Activity.
 - Consult with Clinical Nurse Specialist in Community Health Nursing, Sarah Oliver, RN MSN, CANP for all COVID-19 Policies and Protocols.
- Stay informed with Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment guidelines. Referring frequently for guidelines and questions to their website. <https://covid1ccolorado.gov/>
- Implement Protocols for Horseman to prevent the spread of COVID19 according to guidelines from CDPHE, PROTOCOL:

ALL HORSEMAN ARRIVING AT ARAPAHOE WILL BE UNDER THE STAY AT HOME ORDER UNTIL MAY 27th.

Those living at Arapahoe Park will only leave the premises for essential travel.

All Horsemen will be practicing a HIGH LEVEL of SOCIAL DISTANCING.

All Horsemen will not group in more than 5 persons.

All Horsemen will wear face masks or cloth coverings covering mouth & nose when on the backside.

All Horsemen will have their temperature taken whenever entering the stable gate. Any horseman with a temperature over 99.6 will not be allowed to enter the backside.

All Horsemen must bring with them a HEALTH KIT which must be produced at the stable gate when checking in before moving in.

Thermometer

1 gallon bleach (recommended, but not required due to availability)

1 gallon 60% alcohol (recommended, but not required due to availability)

Face masks or 3 cloth coverings that can be used as mouth & nose covering which can be washed frequently.

Hand Sanitizer or Soap for frequent handwashing

Finger Oximeter (recommended)

All Horsemen will sign the Personal Health Certificate agreement when entering the backside and accepting stall assignment.
